### **2484 REMEMBERS**

Air Cadets and Staff from 2484 (Bassingbourn) Squadron have remembered those who have been injured or lost their lives as a result of war by taking part in a number of Remembrance Services in the local area.

The Squadron took part in parades in the villages of Bassingbourn, Meldreth and Melbourn along with a parade through the town of Royston, led by Drum Major Cadet Sergeant Matthew Sibley and the Squadron Band. During a Service at the War Memorial in Royston, the last post was sounded by Cadet Hollie Woodley, with Cadet Flight Sergeant Ben Johnson laying a poppy wreath on behalf of the Squadron.

Cadet Sergeant Matthew Sibley said *"It was an honour and a privilege to lead the Remembrance parade through Royston on such an important day."*

As the Lord Lieutenant's Cadet for Cambridgeshire, Cadet Warrant Officer Adam Kelly also participated in a Service of Remembrance in Cambridge, escorting the Vice Lord Lieutenant of Cambridgeshire, Mrs Jane Lewin Smith. The Deputy Mayor of Cambridge, Ian Nimmo-Smith led a civic procession from the Guildhall to Great St Mary's Church for the Service of Remembrance, followed by refreshments back at the Guildhall afterwards.

The Squadron has also assisted in collecting for the Poppy Appeal in Royston during the week.
